Writing: The Middle

The middle part of your narrative takes up the majority of your writing. You always want to tell a good story and hold your reader's attention. When writing the middle part of your story, remember to...

- ✓ Add important actions (that SHOW your reader how you reacted)
- ✓ Add sensory details (that help you reader understand your experience)
- ✓ Add your personal thoughts (to help you reader understand your reactions)
- ✓ Maintain suspense (so your reader wants to keep reading)

Some tips...

- ✓ Remember your purpose: to tell about a personal accomplishment or victory.
- ✓ Write freely. Relax and let your ideas flow. Don't worry about having everything correct in the first draft.
- ✓ Add important details that occur to you as you write. You can always cut them out later, if they don't fit!
