* * Some Helpful Tips * *

1. avoid referring to yourself (I) in an essay, unless it's personal
2. never use the following words:
"things", "stuff", "I think", "in conclusion"
3. capitalize He when referring to God
4. capitalize proper nouns
5. capitalize major words in essay titles
6. avoid 2nd POV (e.g. saying "you" to refer to the reader)
