- The continuation must be written in narrative form, paying close attention to the following literary terms:

- o Foreshadowing
- Themes (e.g. good and evil)
- Dialogue
 Symbols (e.g. light and dark)
- The continuation should show honors-level commitment and creativity. Plot twists must be revealed in a creative way that coincides with Dickens' narrative style.
- Each serial edition will be posted to a class blog on Kidblog by a pre-determined date.

This assignment will be worth 30 points. Grading will follow the 6 Traits of Writing.
