WORKS CITED

1. Are the 3 required sources present?
2. Are the header and title perfectly formatted?
3. Is each entry perfectly formatted, according to the type of source? (Especially look at periods and commas!)
4. Is the entire page double spaced?
5. Are hanging indents used when a citation is carried on to a second line?
6. Make sure entries are NOT bulleted or numbered.

PARENTHETICAL CITATIONS

7. Does a Parenthetical Citation appear (at least) at the end of each Body Paragraph?
8. Does a Parenthetical Citation appear immediately after a direct quotation?
9. Does the Parenthetical Citation have a PERIOD after the closing parenthesis?
10. Does the information on the Parenthetical Citation match the information on the Works Cited page?
