
Thesis Statement

Once your research is completed, you should write a thesis statement. The thesis statement identifies the main idea of your paper, serving as the focus of your report. The following formula will help you write your thesis statement.

$S_{ubject} + D_{irection} = T_{hesis} S_{tatement}$



Sample Thesis Statements

The invention of the electric telegraph (*an interesting subject*) had a profound effect on people in this country (*a focus*).

The science of weather forecasting (an interesting subject) has saved millions of lives by predicting dangerous storms (a focus).

The global spread of radio and television (an interesting subject) helped to bring down the Berlin Wall and end the Cold War (a focus).

Form your thesis statement. Review your research notes and choose the main point you want to make about your topic. Using the formula above, write a thesis statement for your report. You may have to write more than one version of the thesis statement before it says exactly what you want it to say.
